Administrative History

The Sudbury Law Association was founded and incorporated in 1923. The volunteer organization represents the interests of lawyers located in the vicinity of Sudbury, Ontario.

Immediate Source of Acquisition

The originals of the records in the fonds were loaned to the archives by Ronald Swiddle (Director of Legal Services/City Solicitor, City of Greater Sudbury) in 2007. The records were copied and the originals returned to Mr. Swiddle.
