Biographical Sketch

Wallace Rankine Nesbitt was born in Toronto, Ontario, on April 17th, 1903, to Wallace and Mary Nesbitt. He attained a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Toronto in 1927, the same year he was admitted to Osgoode Hall Law School. Nesbitt was called to the Bar in 1932. He died on August 18th, 1976.
