Edward Marion Chadwick (1840-1921) was a lawyer, genealogist, author, and artist, in Toronto, Ontario.

Fonds consists of correspondence created by Edward Chadwick. The correspondent is Violet Baker in Tipperary, Ireland. The correspondence primarily discusses family matters, including various family members' involvement in the First World War. Other topics discussed include the various locations of Cooper Hill in Ireland, new accommodations for his law firm, and the celebration marking the fiftieth anniversary of the law firm established by himself and William Beatty.
